Special Conditions, No. 74 Insurance have been updated as follows (bolded):

- 74. Insurance. Prior to award, the successful bidder or bidders will be required to furnish evidence of insurance as follows:
- a. Without in any way limiting Contractor's liability pursuant to the "Indemnification" section of this Agreement, Contractor must maintain in force, during the full term of the Agreement, Insurance in the following amounts and coverages:
- (1) Workers' Compensation, in statutory amounts, with Employers' Liability Limits not less than \$1,000,000 each accident, injury, or illness; and
- (2) Commercial General Liability Insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate for bodily injury, property damage, contractual liability, personal injury, products and completed operations.
- (3) Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence Combined Single Limit for Bodily Injury and Property Damage, including Owned, Non-Owned and Hired auto coverage, as applicable.
- b. Commercial General Liability and Commercial Automobile Liability Insurance policies must be endorsed to provide:
- (1) Name as Additional Insured the City and County of San Francisco, its Officers, Agents, and Employees
- (2) That such policies are primary insurance to any other insurance available to the Additional insureds, with respect to any claims arising out of this Agreement, and that insurance applies separately to each insured against whom claim is made or sulf is brought.
- c. Contractor hereby agrees to waive Workers' Compensation subrogation which any insurer of Contractor may acquire from Contractor by virtue of the payment of any loss. Contractor agrees to obtain any endorsement that may be necessary to effect this waiver of subrogation. The Workers' Compensation policy shall be endorsed with a waiver of subrogation in favor of the City for all work performed by the Contractor, its employees, agents and subcontractors.
- d. All policies shall provide thirty days' advance written notice to the City of reduction or nonrenewel of coverages or cancellation of coverages for any reason. Notices shall be sent to:

- f. Should any of the required insurance be provided under a form of coverage that includes a general annual aggregate limit or provides that claims investigation or legal defense costs be included in such general annual aggregate limit, such general annual aggregate limit shall be double the occurrence or claims limits specified above.
- g. Should any required insurance lapse during the term of this Agreement, requests for payments originating after such lapse shall not be processed until the City receives satisfactory evidence of reinstated coverage as required by this Agreement, effective as of the lapse date. Failure to maintain insurance shall constitute a material breach of this Agreement.
  - i. Approval of the insurance by City shall not relieve or decrease the liability of Contractor hereunder.
- J. If a subcontractor will be used to complete any portion of this agreement, the Contractor shall ensure that the subcontractor shall provide all necessary insurance and shall name the City and County of San Francisco, its officers, agents and employees and the Contractor listed as additional insureds.
