

- It adds Condition 64, "Sugar-Sweetened Beverage Prohibition"



28. Submitting False Claims, Monetary Penalties has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

28. Submitting False Claims, Monetary Penalties

Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code §21.35, any contractor, subcontractor or consultant who submits a false claim shall be liable to the City for the statutory penalties set forth in that section. The text of Section 21.35, along with the entire San Francisco Administrative Code is available on the web at http://library.amlegal.com/nxt/gateway.dll?f=templates&fn=default.htm&vid=amlegal:sanfrancisco_ca. A contractor, subcontractor or consultant will be deemed to have submitted a false claim to the City if the contractor, subcontractor or consultant: (a) knowingly presents or causes to be presented to an officer or employee of the City a false claim or request for payment or approval; (b) knowingly makes, uses, or causes to be made or used a false record or statement to get a false claim paid or approved by the City; (c) conspires to defraud the City by getting a false claim allowed or paid by the City; (d) knowingly makes, uses, or causes to be made or used a false record or statement to conceal, avoid, or decrease an obligation to pay or transmit money or property to the City; or (e) is a beneficiary of an inadvertent submission of a false claim to the City, subsequently discovers the falsity of the claim, and fails to disclose the false claim to the City within a reasonable time after discovery of the false claim.

34. Bid Protests has been deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

34. Bid Protests

Bid protests for purchases of Commodities shall be submitted and responded to in accordance with Rules and Regulations 21.3(i) pertaining to the San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 21.

64. Sugar-Sweetened Beverage Prohibition has been added to the Contract with the following:

64. Sugar-Sweetened beverage Prohibition

Contractor agrees that it will not sell, provide, or otherwise distribute Sugar-Sweetened Beverages, as defined by San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 101, as part of its performance of this Agreement.
