The table in this appendix lists the abbreviations and descriptions of deductions that appear on employees' pay statements.

Note: If the abbreviation that appears on the statement is different than the abbreviation on Report 10, the difference is noted in the description column.

The City-paid contributions to employees' fringe benefits that appear on Report 10 but not on the pay statement are also included.

Note: These employer-paid contributions are included in this appendix because they are considered "memo" deductions.

CAF DENT	10	Cafeteria Plan dental insurance deduction. This is a "pre-tax" deduction for eligible employees on a City or PERS dental plan. This deduction is taken before federal, state, Social Security and SDI taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.	
CAF DISB	13	Cafeteria Plan disability insurance deduction. This is a "pre-tax" deduction for certain eligible employees that is taken before federal, state, Social Security and SDI taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.	
CAF HLTH	6	Cafeteria Plan health insurance deduction. This is a "pre-tax" deduction for eligible employees that is taken before federal, state, Social Security and SDI taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.

CTY DENT	63	Dental plan for eligible employees that is paid entirely by the City. Does not appear on the pay statement.	
CMTR CHK		Commuter Benefit. This is a "pre-tax" deduction that allows an employee to deduct up to \$30.00 per pay period for the purchase of commuter checks. A third party vendor administers this benefit. This deduction is taken before federal, state, Social Security and SDI taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.	
CRED UN1 CRED UN2 CRED UN3		Credit union deduction(s). The Payroll System supports up to three credit union deductions per employee.

DEF COMP	31	Deferred Compensation deduction. This is a City-sponsored tax-deferred plan administered by the Retirement Board through Etna Insurance Company. It is a "pre-tax" deduction that is taken before federal and state income taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.
DI	na	State Disability Insurance tax deduction. A deduction for classifications that are covered by State Disability Insurance. Appears on the pay statement as "SDI."
EE BOND1	33	U.S. Double-E savings bond deduction(s) toward the purchase of

PTX DECP	20	"Pre-tax" dependent care deduction. A deduction for employees who are participating in the Dependent Care Assistance Program (DCAP). This deduction is taken before federal, state, Social Security and SDI taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.
PTAX PLS	4	"Pre-tax" retirement plus pension deduction. A deduction for employees who are exercising their right increasing benefits by "buy back" service credit or payback shortages on a pretax basis through a contract (meaning that they can't change it unless member dies, retires or is terminated for another reason).
PTAX RET	3	"Pre-tax" retirement deduction. The retirement deduction for employees covered by the Judges Retirement System (JRS). This deduction is taken before federal and state income taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.
PTX MISC	49	PTX MISC is a "pre-tax" employee paid Flex Benefits for Municipal Executive Association and some Court classes. This deduction is taken before federal, state, Social Security and SDI taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.
PTX REMB	7	PTX REMB is a Health Service, "pre-tax" medical expense reimbursement program deduction. This deduction is taken before federal, state, Social Security and SDI taxes are calculated. Therefore, taxable gross earnings are lowered and less tax is withheld.

SDI	na	State Disability Insurance tax deduction. A deduction for employees in classifications that are covered by State Disability Insurance. (SDI is not paid by the employer.) Appears as "DI" on Report 10.
SERV FEE	11	Service fee deduction. A deduction paid by employees in classifications covered by agency shop agreements who choose not to become members of the representing unions. This fee deduction applies only to employees who are not exempted.
ST TAX	na	State income tax deduction. Appears as "STATE TAX" on Report 10.

Changes to Deduction Descriptions

This Bulletin affects **Payroll Offices** only. This procedure updates your *Procedures Manual, Appendix H—Deduction Descriptions*.

Deduction Names and Descriptions

Two deduction descriptions abbreviations have been changed, as described below. The changes will appear on employee pay stubs and Report 10 beginning July 29, 2003.

TRNS BEN

This is a new deduction description abbreviation. This amount is the employee's pre-tax deduction to pay for transit and vanpool expenses. Employees may deduct up to \$100 per month.

<u>Note</u>: TRNS BEN previously appeared as CMTR CHK The Calendar Year-to-Date (YTD) amount for TRNS BEN will include the amount withheld under CMTR CHECK between January and June 2003, as well as withholdings for TRNS BEN.

MISCEL-4

This is the post-tax deduction that allows those who need more than \$100 per month in transit expenses to withhold the additional amount they require.
