Previously-Issued RFP: Terminal 2 Concession Program - Request for Proposals dated October 2009 (the "RFPs")

On behalf of the San Francisco International Airport, we invite you to submit a Proposal for this Concession Opportunity pursuant to the RFPs, as modified and supplemented by this Addendum. Please review the RFPs and this Addendum carefully.

The RFPs are modified and supplemented as set forth below. If there are any inconsistencies between the terms of the RFPs and the terms of this Addendum, then the terms of this Addendum shall prevail. Section references below are to the RFP and are provided for convenience of reference only, and are not necessarily correct or complete. Capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meaning given them in the RFPs.

1. **Part V.1. and V.3., Deadline for Submission of Written Questions or Requests for Clarification:** The date is extended to Thursday, November 5, 2009, 4:00 p.m. (San Francisco Time).
2. **Part V.1. and V.4., Submittal Deadline:** The date for all Terminal 2 concessions' proposals extended to Wednesday, January 6, 2010, 2:00 p.m. (San Francisco Time).
3. **Part V.1., Schedule:** The apparent successful proposer will be identified in March 2010 and estimated award date is April 2010.


4. **Tour of Terminal 2:** The Airport will conduct tours of Terminal 2 for parties interested in submitting a proposal for any of the Terminal 2 leases. The tours are intended for prospective proposers. For safety and security concerns, each tour is limited to 15 attendees. No more than three representatives from each company will be allowed on the tours to accommodate as many potential proposers as possible.

Registration is mandatory. The Airport may not be able to accommodate all who want a tour of Terminal 2. Those who are granted a tour must wear closed-toe, hard-soled shoes. A hard hat, safety goggles, and safety vest will be provided by the Airport.

If you are interested in a tour of Terminal 2, please complete and fax or email the attached form to Airport Revenue Development and Management no later than November 9, 2009, 4:00 p.m. (San Francisco Time). We will confirm your tour registration the following week.
